## Connecting

In the last month, the congregation at Forks Mennonite made the difficult decision to close the church. The congregation continues to meet as plans are being made. We invite your prayers for them as they find their way in this time.

The office received communication from three congregations about their affiliation with Indiana-Michigan Mennonite Conference.:

- Burr Oak ended their affiliation as of September 1. Their leadership had indicated for some time this would happen when the congregation had decided what new connection they would move toward.
- Michigan Avenue has decided to end their affiliation as of the end of December 2016.
- Howard-Miami is processing their affiliation and hopes to have a decision as early as November or as late as spring.

John Powell hosted the [third Michigan Leaders Summit](#) on September 8 in Midland, MI. (you might have to sign into Facebook to see post about this)

MLT will host a conference call next week to hear from staff and congregational coaches about how to live into "Renewing a Vision," especially the spiritual practices.

Tim Lichti, John Powell and Dan Miller will participate in a consultation later this month, called by [Mennonite Disaster Service](#), to consider a long-term project in Detroit that would be a cooperative effort between multiple Mennonite agencies.

## Credentialing and Leadership Development

Doug Kaufman will license and install Katie Johnson Misz as pastor of family life at Waterford Mennonite Church, Goshen, on September 25. Dan Miller will install Bob Brown as pastor at First Mennonite Church, Indianapolis, on October 16

The fall Journey event took place last weekend with input on Christian formation by Gilberto Flores. It was a challenging and hopeful weekend. IN-MI had 12 participants and mentors at the weekend. Journey is a three-year conference based leadership development program.

Congregational Coaches will meet with Lee Schmucker in October to learn more about leading from within through understanding the DiSC profile.

The mid-states conferences (Central District, Illinois, Ohio and Indiana-Michigan) have begun planning a joint training for spring 2017 on responding to accusations of clergy sexual misconduct.

## Financial Report

Our income for the month of August was \$14,568 below budget and for the year to date \$19,254 below budget. Our expenses for the month of August were \$2,398 below budget and for the year to date \$5,117 below budget. Our expenses do not change as greatly as our income and will probably remain in this range. Last month I mentioned that we our income is normally low at the beginning of the year but this seems a bit unusual. We were aware of a decrease in income due to some congregations leaving but we are concerned about this amount of drop. This is a concern for prayer.


