## Conference Staff Updates

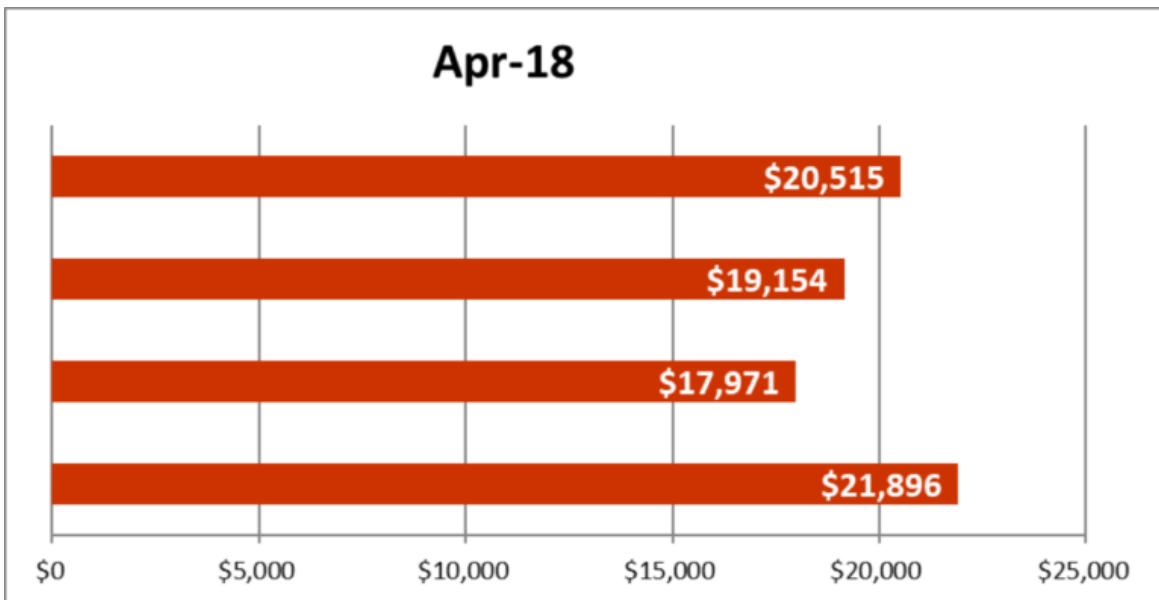
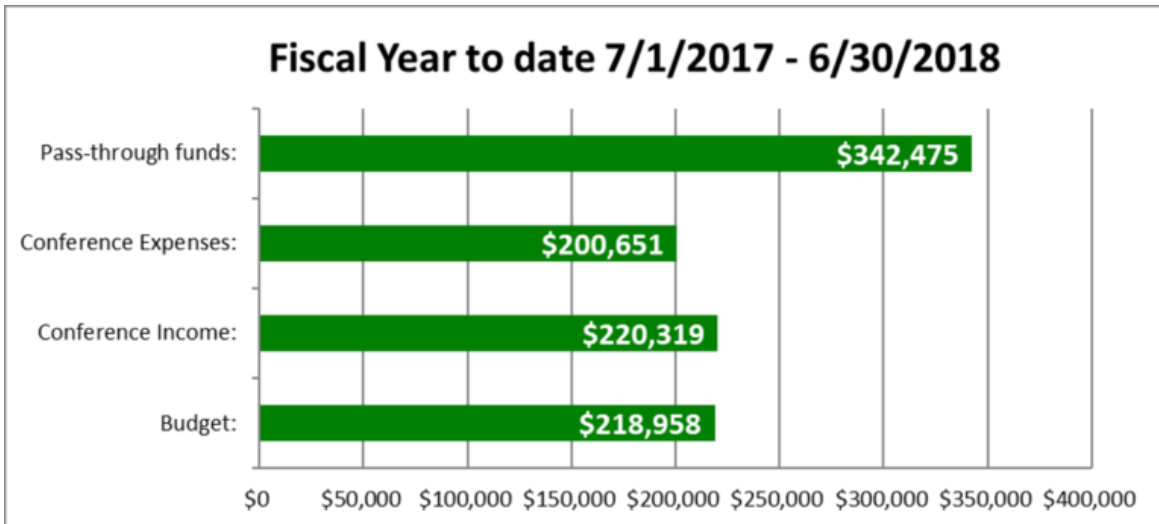
