We invite prayers for Dan, Sharon and Tim.

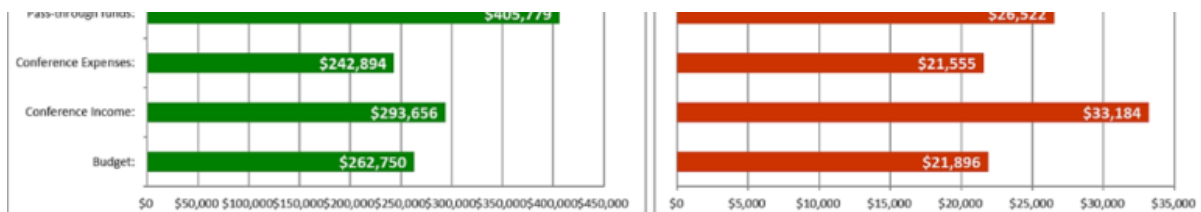
Time to Make a Move
